Township Officials Report-

Supervisor- A. Supervisor said the Township has received bids to upgrade the boiler and baseboard heat at the Township Center. The cost will be between \$75,000.00 and \$100,000.00 dollars. The Township is responsible for half the expense.

B. Walmart Manager Tina Frank and property owner Spyridon Hortis have given approval for the cleanup of the property across from Walmart.

C. The board unanimously adopted the revised GA Handbook edited by the Supervisors Division of TOI.

D. The board unanimously adopted the minimum monthly payment requirement of \$304.00 as established by the Supervisors Division of TOI effective June 1, 2019.

Highway Commissioner- Caitlin Burke from Gewalt Hamilton gave the board the MS4 Presentation on the outfall and storm water runoff in the township. Runoff that is not connected to a sewer system is tested for IEPA compliance. The Fox River Study Group Report is on the Township website under Highway Department.

Old Business- Senior Committee - Trustee Davis- May 22, 2019 the seniors are going to Marriott to see Footloose. The senior summer picnic is June 6, 2019 at the Township.

Grants- Trustee Turner – The Township has received three iPads and will receive three more for each of the next three years. The Township is not a 501C3, which makes us ineligible for some grants. The ComEd grant has been applied for.

Transportation -Trustee Grant – Said possibly Uber and Lyft could be used to fill in the transportation deficit in Lake County. The Township has some new van drivers, Art Hansen, Dennis Sheehan and Bill Fick.

Parks - Trustee Shepard – Breezy Hill has come up with a landscape design for Osmond Park. The Garden Club wants to plant a tree in the Township, they will be planting a White Oak made available with a Garden Club donation. Osmond Park entrance will be planted with perennials. The revamped Disk Course will also be a walking trail.

New Business – A. The Township and the Village are going to update the April 2004 Antioch Township Parks Cooperative.

B. The Intergovernmental Park Committee appointments from the Township will be Trustees Turner and Shepard. Mayor Hansen will pick his designees. The new committee will review the IGA.

C. The Township Street Light Program began in the early 80's. This program helped light up Township neighborhoods for safety. In recent years we were only collecting 25% of the required expense. The Township has increased the Homeowners Associations percentage by 25%. The Township Mosquito Abatement program will continue. We will approach Homeowners Associations to help test. Trustee Grant thinks abatement is an environmental issue and thinks process will have to be ecofriendly.

D. Additional Township Meetings - Supervisor would like trustees to bring in new ideas from the community so a comprehensive plan can be developed. There has to be plans for the Township to stay viable.

Trustee Shepard informed the board that the Lions Club has funds available for emergency events during this rainy season.

There was no further business to come before the board. Kris Shepard made a motion to adjourn, second by Judy Davis. Motion carried and the meeting adjourned at 8:10 P.M.
