All Advocate Aurora Health Hospitals were lit up with blue lights every evening in May honoring the memory of those lost and to express gratitude for the health care heroes in the COVID-19 pandemic. Going forward, all the hospitals across Advocate Aurora Health Care will now simultaneously pause at 10 am on the 19th of every month to observe a moment of silence for 19 seconds, and this began on May 19.



While several drug trials are ongoing, there is currently no proof that hydroxychloroquine or any other drug can cure or prevent COVID-19. The misuse of hydroxychloroquine can cause serious side effects and illness and can even lead to death. WHO is coordinating efforts to develop and evaluate medicines to treat COVID-19.

FACT:

There are currently NO drugs licensed for the treatment or prevention of COVID-19.

8 am until 4pm (or until 500 tests completed each day)

Who can be tested?

- All individuals with symptoms

And the following groups WITH OR WITHOUT symptoms

- Individuals exposed to confirmed COVID-19 cases
- Individuals with compromised immune systems and/or chronic medical conditions
- Healthcare workers
- First responders
- Employees of correctional facilities
- Employees who support Critical Infrastructure (grocery stores, pharmacies, restaurants, gas stations, public utilities, factories, childcare and sanitation)
- Individuals slated to receive elective surgery within 72 hours

Definition of Symptoms

Fever, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell

Photo ID required – Professional identification if applicable

IF YOU HAVE SYMPTOMS OF RESPIRATORY ILLNESS such as fever, cough, shortness of breath, **stay home and call your doctor**. Distance yourself from others in the household and if possible, stay in your own bedroom and use your own bathroom. Seek medical care right away, if your illness is worsening (for example, you have difficulty breathing). **DO NOT walk into a healthcare facility, urgent care clinic, or hospital before calling**. If you do not have a primary care provider contact Lake County Health Department - (847) 377-8800 & choose option 1.

Call 911 if you are having a medical emergency & alert dispatch if you have respiratory symptoms.

REMEMBER TO WEAR YOUR MASK WHEN NECESSARY

Phase 3 Guidelines – Began May 29th

- **A cloth face covering, or mask is REQUIRED** when outside & 6-foot distancing is difficult to maintain.
(Do not use masks with children under the age of two or on anyone who has trouble breathing, is unconscious, incapacitated, or otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance)
- Clean hands often with soap & water (20 seconds) or use hand sanitizer at least 60% alcohol.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, mouth with unwashed hands.
- Cover your cough & sneeze with a tissue or your elbow.
- Check with your healthcare provider about any medical appointments.
- If you are on dialysis, you should **NOT** postpone your treatments.
